Principal's Report:

Yard Improvements:

- Only other potential stall is if there may be other construction happening this summer. Paving is supposed to be repaired. Cannot have two contractors on site at the same time.
- Potentially, structure will be in this summer (3)
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- Stacie will provide the sub committee a catalogue for ideas.It will be installed between the primary and junior yards.
- Kinder yard improvements. Will ask kinder teachers for requests. Will ask parents on the Arklan parent page for donations.
