*** PROCEDURE FOR DROPPING OFF FOOD & GIFTS ***

If participating in a food/toy drive, the following guidelines are provided from Public Health:

Look for alternatives to collecting items if possible. For example – grocery store gift cards that can be sent home with students or gift card/money donations to an organization.

- Currently, there is no evidence of COVID-19 transmission from packaging.
 - The key measures for food/toy drives is limiting close contact with others while dropping off items, ensuring people are well while doing so, and performing hand hygiene before and after dropping off items.

Arklan students and school staff are:

- 1. Drop box locations in each classroom are in a corner where physical distancing can be implemented (students will drop off their items one at a time).
- 2. Students/staff will perform hand hygiene before and after dropping off the item.
- 3. We will encourage students (as age appropriate) to wear their masks while walking to drop off the items.
- 4. Items will be left outside the front door at designated times for pick up.
- 5. For community members who wish to donate, please self-screen before coming and wear a mask when delivering to the window. Items will be accepted at the Welcome Window all week during school hours. (when dropping of please stand at least 2 m apart).

SNOW DAY

At times, during the winter season, it is necessary to cancel school bus transportation due to road conditions. If buses are cancelled, information will be posted to school Facebook pages, all UCDSB social media platforms, shared with local media outlets and emailed to all parents signed up for My Family Room by 6:15 a.m.

IMPORTANT CHANGE ON INCLIMENT WEATHER DAY

FOR 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

Due to the COVID-19 protocol, for the 2020-2021 school year, <u>schools are required to be</u> <u>closed to students for Inclement Weather Days</u>. These days will be designated as Remote Learning Days and staff will provide learning support for all students.

NEW COVID-19 ASSESSMENT CENTRE

The North Grenville COVID-19 Assessment Centre is a COVID-19 Swab Centre and Physician Assessment Centre.

The purpose of the centre is to provide a safe space for patients with COVID symptoms to be tested and assessed by an MD (if required), while keeping family practices "clean" and safe for our vulnerable patient population.

The centre is located at 15 Campus Drive, Kemptville, Ontario, open Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm.

They offer:

COVID-19 Swab

For individuals six months of age and up who meet provincial eligibility criteria for COVID testing. <u>Physician Assessment</u>

They offer a full physician assessment for those who are unable to see their family physician in person or for those who are feeling unwell due to COVID-19 symptoms.

Patients do NOT need a referral from a family doctor to be seen.

How it works:

Same-day appointments are given on the spot. When you arrive at the staging area (County Road 44) you will be issued a "time pass" that indicates what time you should present yourself and your pass at 15 Campus Drive (Bell Hall) during your allocated time that same day.

No online or telephone appointment necessary.
